

Order Disclaimer: We recommend buying all wall slats at the same time for your project. Otherwise, we cannot guarantee matching wall slats if adding to an order. In the event additional wall slats needs to be ordered, wall slats may differ in color, grain, texture, and/or size due to inherent variations in natural wood products. When ordering, always factor in at least one full box for any/all unforeseen damage that may occur during the life of your wall slat. Please consider and allow for a waste factor of 3-5% on normal layouts and 5-10% on detailed layouts such as 45-degree angles, patterns, border work, etc.
